Introduction

The following tables provide statistics and lists for the nominal system. The tables are based on a complete analysis of the lexical stock presented in Bauer, and thus cover the literature treated in that lexicon; the frequency lists are dependent upon Bruce M. Metzger, *Lexical Aids for Students of New Testament Greek* (Enlarged edition, Princeton, N.J., 1958), and thus are confined to the New Testament.

Students will find these tables useful in a number of ways: 1) they will be able to gain some impression of the distribution of elements in the nominal system among the several inflectional patterns; 2) they will be able to check themselves, especially in the initial stages, against the lists provided here, particularly with reference to categories of less quantitative prominence; 3) they will be able to study words of high frequency according to their inflectional groupings; 4) they will find the structure of the tables a helpful summary of the nominal system as presented in this grammar.

With each category is provided 1) a statistical summary, and 2) either an exhaustive catalogue (with reference to Bauer) or a catalogue of items of high frequency (dependent upon Metzger). The presentation of an exhaustive catalogue for each category would not appear to serve any useful purpose.
